






The Psychomotor Domain (action-based)

INTRA-SCHOOL COMPETITION: BEST OUT OF WASTE ACTIVITY

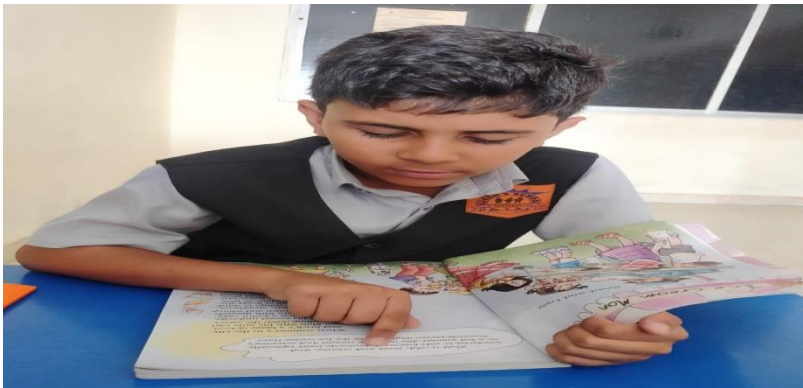


WEBINAR: OUTSMARTING THE SMART PHONE

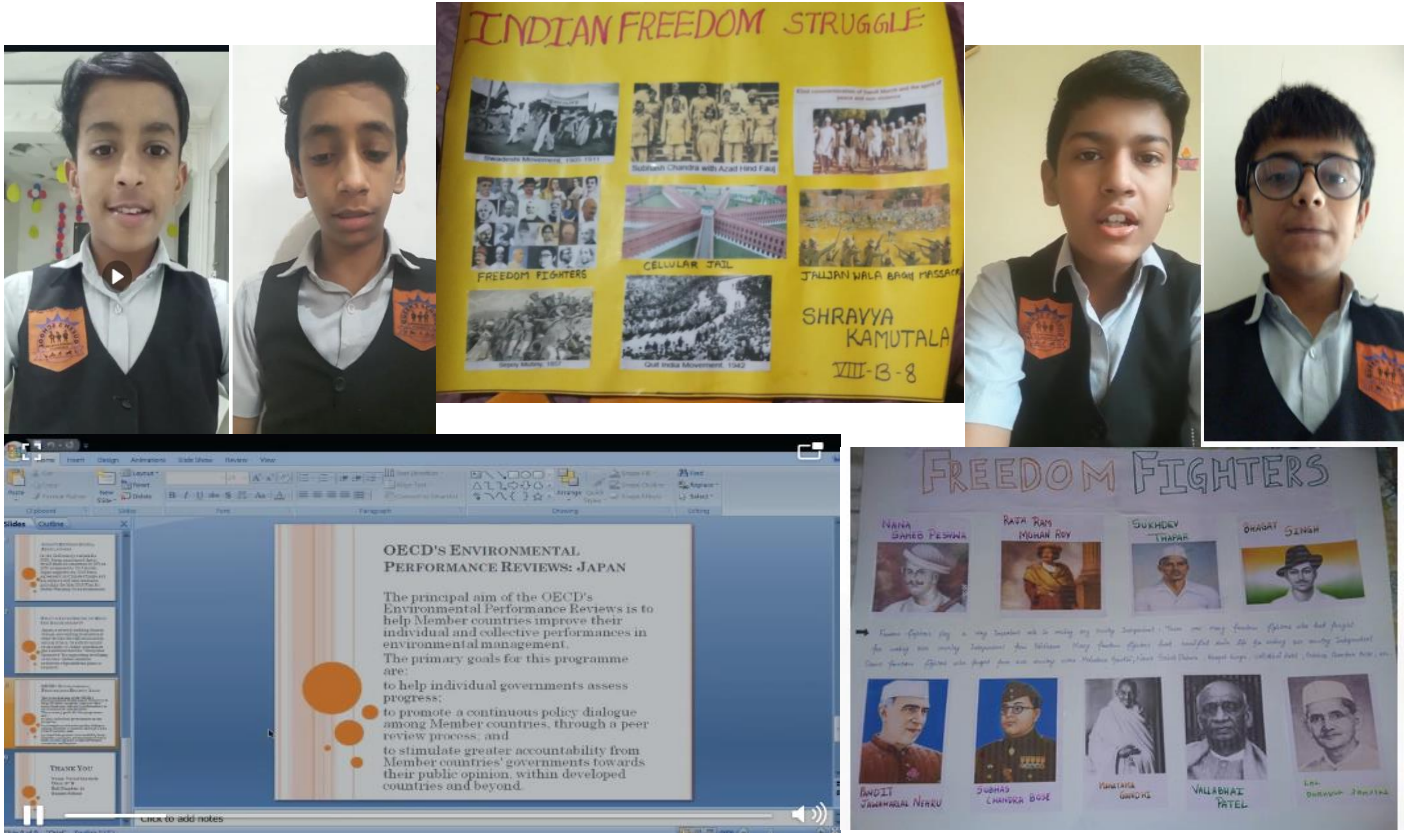
ACTIVITY: NO BAKE COOKING ACTIVITY

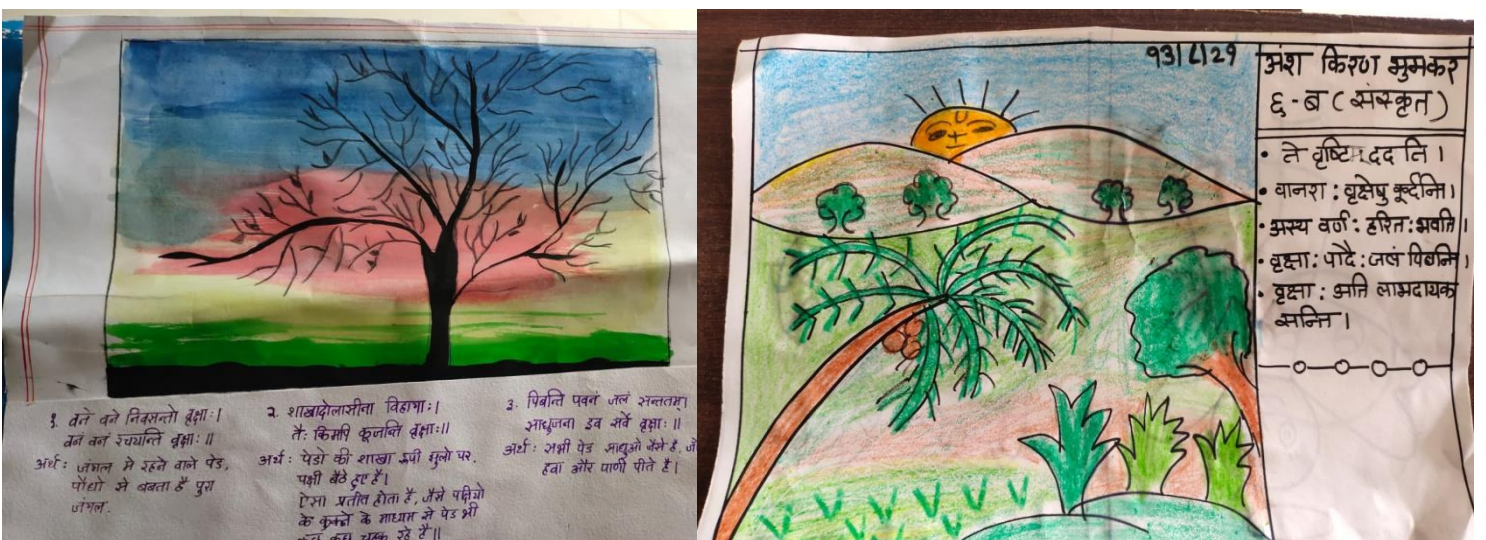
SOCIAL SCIENCE DAY

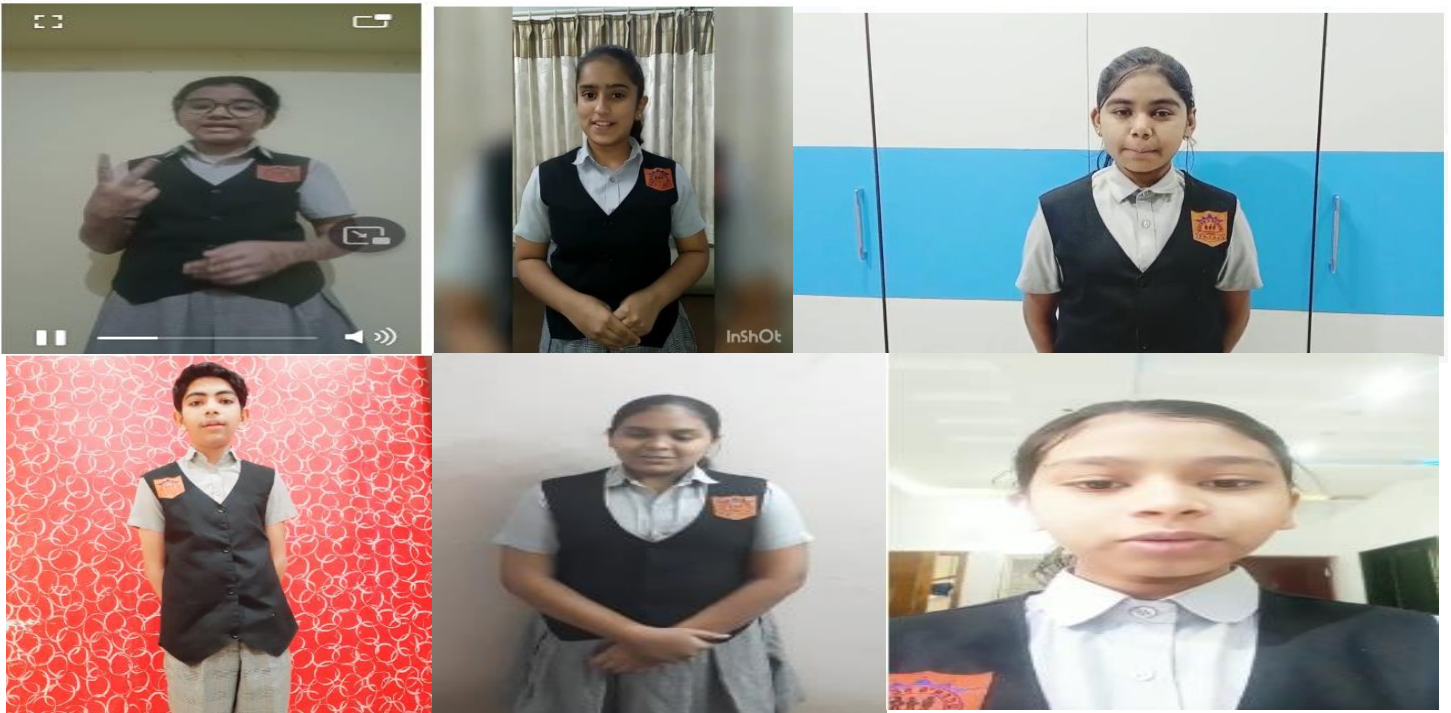
VACCINATION CAMP FOR CLASS X

HELPING MY FAMILY

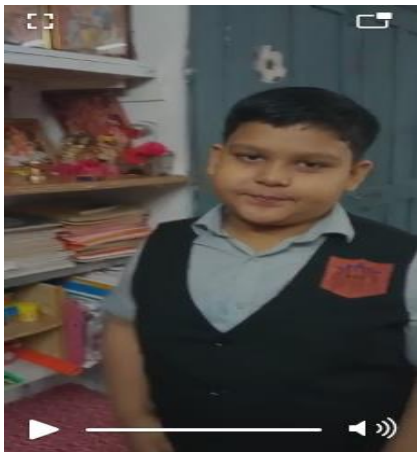

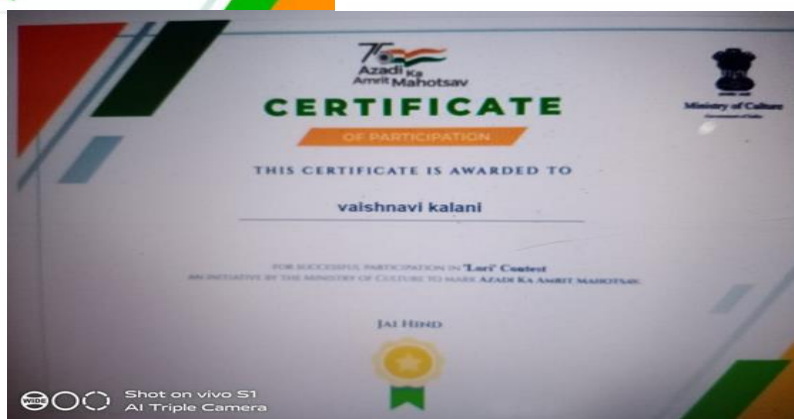
RANGOLI COMPETITION
